She now has trained church planters who are guiding her in community to follow and serve the Lord in hope.

> **TOGETHER IN HIS MISSION,** Dr. John Wagenveld

Before Sam-Ol Nget knew Jesus, he was a Buddhist. His brother Sarann first told him about Jesus but Sam-Ol ridiculed him for his beliefs.

Very career and money-focused, Sam-Ol assumed that if he believed in Jesus Christ, he would be too busy to work. While away for a year working, he lost all of his property and his wife passed away. Discouraged, Sam-Ol remembered what his brother had told him and decided to go to church. At first he was embarrassed to be there, but gradually, things changed. "I began to have joy, hope, and the desire to go to church," Sam-Ol shares. Since then, his life has completely changed.

You helped to equip Sam-Ol by providing biblical and practical training



through Multiplication Network. He leads meetings in Trapaingchrey, Cambodia every Sunday afternoon to worship God, study the Bible, and pray together.

Sam-Ol knows that without Jesus, his life would be miserable and he'd be walking in darkness. He has a passion now to share the Gospel with others.

"I want to see people in every village in Cambodia to believe in God, worship Him, and make disciples!"



Adriano and Ruth Made are church planters in the Dominican Republic who have seen the Lord's faithfulness despite the COVID-19 pandemic affecting their church planting work.

Their house church began with 15 people but during the first closures in 2020, attendance decreased. **"Far from being discouraged, we kept praying and having fellowship with a small group,"** say Adriano and Ruth.

Their perseverance paid off—after several weeks, two young people in the group decided to give their lives to Jesus Christ. A few weeks later, another person visited and also received the Lord.

They continued to pray and more people joined. "As a result, we now work with a new group of believers that God has added for His glory," Ruth shares.



In spite of the challenges they faced, Adriano and Ruth were diligent to the call of church planting. **"Prayer motivated us to keep going forward and the church we started made a difference by keeping its doors open,"** they report.

Adeline Boniface grew up in a Christian home but did not have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. As an adult, she became addicted to alcohol. Adeline was unhappy in that lifestyle but couldn't seem to change. When her husband also began to drink excessively, everything got worse for their family.

Adeline met Kevin, a church planter trained through Multiplication Network. He felt compelled to share the Gospel with Adeline. Upon hearing it, she knew she needed Jesus so that she could be free from her addiction. She has never been the same again! Adeline shares,

Because of your support, Kevin received training through Multiplication Network, started a new church, and led Adeline to Jesus. She became actively involved in the church and now her life is filled with great joy and peace as she grows in her faith everyday.

Adeline's daily prayer request was that God would reach her husband one day and God answered her prayers! Today, her husband's life has been changed drastically. **Adeline and her husband continue to enjoy God's** goodness in their life.



The Roma people, or Gypsies as they are commonly called, have been living in Latvia since the 15th century. Kaspars Paucs belongs to the Roma Nation and gave his life to Jesus Christ about 10 years ago when he had a tumor in his nose that kept him from breathing normally. Desperate for a solution, Kaspars visited a church and they prayed over him. He was completely healed and he knew God was powerful and sovereign.

Kaspars became a leader in his home church in Ventspils. Recently, he went through the church planter training program provided by you through Multiplication Network.

He and his wife have started outreach centers in Talsi and Jelgava. Their

goal is to reach their own people and the Lord is blessing their ministry. Kaspars and Evija's hearts are not only committed to reach Gypsies but also Latvians and Russians living in this country.

In addition to the outreach work, Kaspars is leading his congregation through Multiplication Network's training to reach more communities around Ventspils, one of the main port cities in Latvia.



Celenia Cabrera received the Multiplication Network training to become a church planter because of you! She is now leading a small group in Bilbao, Spain. Several people and some of their relatives who are not believers are attending her small group. Celenia says,

"EVERYTHING WE HAVE LEARNED HAS INSPIRED ME AND HELPED ME TO COPE WITH THE MINISTRY I DO, PREPARING ME TO TAKE ON MORE RESPONSIBILITY IN THE FUTURE AND THUS RESPOND TO THE NEED TO PLANT CHURCHES."

Celenia has caught the vision to multiply the work. She is already training another woman to be a church planter.

Additionally, she has plans to expand beyond her immediate community.



"I am keeping in my heart everything that I have received because I think it is very important for me to practice now in the home group so that later when the group grows and multiplies, I can, with the Lord's help, take the step of perhaps starting a church plant in another village with no witness of the Gospel."

The training you provide through Multiplication Network has equipped Celenia and stirred her passion for sharing the Gospel with her community and beyond!



Brenda Sánchez began the work of starting a church in Managua, Nicaragua in March of 2020. As with the rest of the world, she and her team were surprised and devastated by the arrival of the COVID-19 pandemic. "Our mother church closed due to the circumstances," Brenda shares.

But the training she received from Multiplication Network because of your generosity was effective in helping her share the Gospel despite the situation.

Brenda and her team go out house to house twice a week to share the Gospel. On Monday and Saturday, they have worship services and on Sunday



they have a time of teaching. "It has been a beautiful experience to reach people for Christ," Brenda shares. "It is not easy but God has helped us in this time."

The fruit of Brenda's labor is evident—they have more than 50 adults and children attending the new church. **"The Lord has been faithful,"** Brenda says. Despite the difficulties they've encountered, she is optimistic about continuing the work. She asks for your prayer for God's guidance in everything they do. Joshua Ayuba is a missionary teacher in a primary school in Kwanginu, Nigeria. Before he received the church planter training provided by you through Multiplication Network, he believed he would eventually retire from missionary work. "But my encounter with Multiplication Network has taught me that mission work and sharing the Gospel is a lifelong exercise," he shares. **"I'm so thankful because the trainings I have received have strengthened my zeal for preaching the Gospel."**

He has learned how to initiate conversations with strangers to share the Gospel with them. In his target area of Niger State, there are many Fulani Muslims.

"THANKS TO MULTIPLICATION NETWORK'S TRAINING, MANY COMMUNITIES HAVE BEEN REACHED, INCLUDING CORE MUSLIM AREAS."

Joshua shares that he learned to be aware and respectful of local cultures and to apply wisdom while relating and sharing the Gospel with them without drawing attention or upsetting the larger Muslim community.

"When I first got involved with Multiplication Network, I did not expect much from it," Joshua confesses. "But eventually, it changed my view and method of evangelizing." Before the training, Joshua tended to stay away from Muslims altogether. **"But now, I also preach to Muslims wherever I meet them. Multiplication Network's training has equipped me on how to work better with people, how to stand boldly before a large crowd, and broadened my understanding and knowledge of the Bible."**
